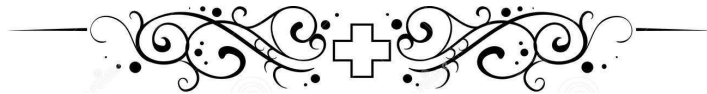
EPWORTH Children's Home
